Powder Pink

Base Card - A = 1 x 11 1/2" x 5 3/4"

- scored & folded in half

B = 1 x 3 5/8" x 1/2"

Very Vanilla

C = 1 x 5 1/2" x 3 7/8"

D = 1 x 4" x 4"

E = 1 x 3 5/8" x 1"

Berry Burst

F = 1 x 3 5/8" x 5 3/8"

Metric

Powder Pink

Base Card - A = 1 x 29.2cm x 14.6cm

- scored & folded in half

B = 1 x 9.2cm x 1.2cm

Very Vanilla

C = 1 x 13.9cm x 9.8cm

D = 1 x 10.1cm x 10.1cm

E = 1 x 9.2cm x 2.5cm

Berry Burst

F = 1 x 9.2cm x 13.6cm

Technique Colouring

Tutorial –

- 1 Randomly stamp E – Berry Burst with flower from Tea Together in Berry Burst Ink
- 2 Place E – Very Vanilla inside Country Floral Embossing Folder prior to running through Big Shot
- 3 Adhere B – Powder Pink along bottom of embossed Very Vanilla & the to the bottom half of stamped Berry Burst, trimming sides if necessary
- 4 Adhere to C – Very Vanilla & then to A – Base Card – Petal Pink
- 5 Stamp Tea Cup image direct onto D – Very Vanilla in Petal Pink Ink
- 6 Colour & blend with Watercolour Pencils colour of choice. I've used Calypso Coral on mine as it was closed to Petal Pink
- 7 Die cut with tea cup from Tea Time Framelits by running through Big Shot
- 8 Adhere to Card Front with Stampin' Dimensionals
- 9 Stamp 3 x flowers onto D – Very Vanilla in Berry Burst Ink
- 10 Colour & Blend flowers with Watercolour Pencils –
Petals Rich Razzleberry
Middle Daffodil Delight
Leaves Daffodil Delight & Old Olive
- 11 Die cut with flower from Tea Time Framelits by running through Big Shot
- 12 Arrange & adhere to top of tea cup with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals
- 13 Stamp sentiment onto remaining D – Very Vanilla in Berry Burst Ink
- 14 Place die from Stitched Labels Framelits over top of sentiment, place in Big Shot BUT only run through half way. Reverse Big Shot. Your sentiment should only be half cut
- 15 Remove die & reposition over opposite side of sentiment & repeat above step. Your sentiment should be cut a little small than actual die is in size
- 16 Adhere to Card Front with Stampin' Dimensionals
- 17 Adhere Clear Rhinestones to centre of flowers & randomly to Card Front
